Report on Sanitation Awareness program(UBA)

The NSS cell - SNTI is organized a camp on the theme “UNNAT BHARAT ABHIYAN” for taking household and village survey to implement the UBA development activities in the selected cluster villages on **20-11-2019**. Under this program our college adopted two villages namely Thippaiguda of Manchal Mandal and Kurmidda of Yacharam Mandal organized “SANITATION AWARENESS PROGRAM”. During this camp, UBA members and students have gathered the following information. About 50 students participated in the program.

Basic Information: Details collected about household member information such as Level Education, Aadhar Card holder and non-holder, Bank A/C, Computer Literate and Occupation.

Water Resource: Gathered details about types of water resource used by the People such as Water at Home, Community Water Tap, Hand Pump (Public / Private), Open Well (Public / Private), Mode of Water Storage (Community/Individual) and any other source.

Source of Energy and Power: Gathered details about availability of Electricity Connection to Household, Electricity Availability per day (hours). Details about Lighting using Electricity / Kerosene / Solar Power, and details of Cooking using LPG / Biogas / Kerosene / Wood / Cow Dung / Agro-Residues / Electricity.

Beneficiaries of Govt. Schemes: Details collected about beneficiaries under Govt. schemes such as PM Jan Dhan Yojana, PM Ujjwala Yojana, PM Awas Yojana, Mudra Yojana, Swachh Bharat Mission Toilet, PM Jivan Jyoti Bima Yojana.

Our NSS volunteers and students interacted with the people directly and educated them about the importance of sanitation services.

The overall objective of this programme is to “improve the quality of life of rural populace by providing safe, convenient and sustainable water, sanitation services and better hygiene”
