




2. SWATCH BHARAT PROGRAM






Fig.2 Rally from Peoples Plaza







Fig.4 End of the Program & Group Photo of NSS Volunteers



4. GUIDING LIGHT FOUNDATION








10. INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY
