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Introduction

Clean and Green campus audit is a tool of environment management system which is used methodologically for protection and conservation of environment and sustenance of ecosystem. It creates environmental culture, develops sustainable solutions to environmental problems and provides solutions to various social and economic needs (APHA, 1981). It provides the concept of green building and oxygenated building which in turn useful to provide a healthy atmosphere to the stakeholders.

Green campus audit is a type of assessment to ensure that the Organization campus should be in greenish in terms of planting a large number of trees, herbs, shrubs, climbers and lawns in the campus which in turn not only to reduce the environmental pollution and soil erosion but also useful for biodiversity conservation, landscape management, proper water irrigation, natural topography and vegetation (Gowri and Harikrishnan, 2014). Similarly, in order to ensure the green campus, maintenance of eco-friendly campus which lead to environment neat and clean, solid state management, recycling of water, disposal of sewage and waste materials including electronic and biomedical wastes, plastic use, and etc. should be followed efficiently in the organization campus for the benefit of stakeholders.

1. About the College

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3.Site inspection

1. It is observed that how the environment is protected in the campus and by what means eco friendly atmosphere is being given to the stakeholders. It is assessed the strengths and weaknesses of the auditee's management controls and risks associated with their failure in green campus facilities were recorded.
2. Gathering audit evidence i.e., collecting data and information from the auditee as per the audit protocol were carried out.
3. An exit meeting was conducted to explain the audit findings with Management Representatives and staff members along with audit team in brief.

5.Audit Observations

Flora and Fauna in the campus

Ensuring the rich biodiversity in the green campus is an important parameter which reflected the real-time ecosystem. Plants are indicators for assessing the varying levels of environmental quality. In general, plants improve the outdoor air quality with increased oxygen levels and reduced temperature and carbon-di-oxide. The green and varying colour of the flowering plants improve the ambience of the environment. The record on maintenance of the plant biomass and its management are important with respect to green campus initiatives. The existence of such plants and birds in the green campus may be recorded for the rich flora and fauna which are being considered as a value addition to the campus.


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The observations indicated that the Scient college campus the commonly available native as well as wild plant species in the college campus are Neem (*Azadirachta indica*), Mango (*Mangifera indica*), Guava (*Psidium guajava*), Coconut (*Cocos nucifera*), Hibiscus (*Hibiscus rosa sinensis*), Royal poinciana (*Delonix regia*), Jackfruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), False Ashoka (*Monoon longifolium*), Fig (*Ficus racemosa*), Sacred Fig (*Ficus religiosa*), Singapore Cherry (*Muntingia calabura*), Yellow Flame tree (*Peltophorum pterocarpum*), Orchid tree (*Bauhinia variegata*), Weeping fig (*Ficus Benjamina*), Spider plant.

The predominant families of various monocot and dicot plants found in the Scinet campus are Arecaceae, Fabaceae, Anacardiaceae, Myrtaceae, Vitaceae, Moraceae, Muntingiaceae, Proteaceae, Annonaceae, Lauraceae.

The visiting and living birds in the campus are Shikra (*Accipiter badius*) Crow (*Corvus splendens*), Pigeon (*Columba livia domestica*), Birds (*Aves*), Garden lizard (*Calotes versicolor*), Butterfly (*Euploea core*), Squirrel (*Sciurus sp.*), Carpenter ants (*Camponotus sp.*). Barn owl (*Tyto alba*) was seen perching in one of the trees.

More than 25% of campus is covered with greenery .

The campus has a good number of trees, plants, shrubs and lawns. It is further observed that all the plants are growing profusely and showing healthier free from pests and diseases attack.

Water resources and conservation methods

The main source of water is bore well source and open well

Rainwater harvesting system is a traditional old practice not only in drought prone areas and also in areas having seasonal rainfall. Now the threatening features of the lower ground level of water has created a revamp of newly featured rainwater harvesting systems. There is a system of rain water harvesting in the new block.


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5.3. Solid Waste Management



Shade giving trees in the paths, flowering trees in the avenues and fruit trees at the back yards also would attract birds, bees, butterflies and squirrels. Maintaining small ponds/open water sources and reservoirs will attract these small harmless animals to the campus.

7. Role of Eco club, Nature club, Associations, Cells, Forums, NCC and NSS bodies in green campus initiatives

Professional implementation of all the Eco plans in the campus should be done through the Eco clubs, Nature clubs, Associations, and NSS (National Service Scheme). All the students, members of staff and employers should be mandatorily members of the club and should do tree planting and maintenance of greenery in the campus periodically. Conducting frequent seminars, conferences, workshops, awareness rallies, etc. on topics relevant to the environment is necessary to educate and create awareness among the students and staff members.

8. Conduct of outreach programmes for dissemination of Green campus motto and green pledge initiatives

Awareness programme on the green campus initiatives needs to be accounted in a sustainable manner. Its benefits and self-sustainability can be projected for wider centric on earth and ecology conservation. Innovative practices that add up credentials in implementing the green campus which needs to be promoted in the awareness programme to the students and staff members including public domain. Technology driven solutions initiated by the green campus organization can also be disseminated and documented successively for propagating the attitude of the green campus in wider masses.

Details of extension activities such as cleanliness drive, swacchata awareness and tree plantation by the strong NSS Cell are enclosed.



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9. Best practices followed on Green Campus initiatives in the Organization

- It is observed that the campus maintaining more than 25% of the green cover area after building construction as per the World Green Building Council guidelines to provide a healthy environment to the stakeholders.
- Maintaining small ponds/open water sources and reservoirs will attract these small harmless animals to the campus.
- The classrooms and computer laboratories, and parking space is well ventilated.
- The organization leader being a major leading the NSS team has motivated and inculcated strong sense of commitment in protecting and nurturing the environment. The students are involved in planting and cleanliness drive .

10. Recommendations

- Many native trees may be planted in unutilized areas in the campus. The trees that produce more oxygen and absorb more CO₂ could be planted to maintain a healthy environment for the stakeholders.
- Vegetables, fruits, and greens could be cultivated in the college campus through terrace garden, kitchen garden and indoor garden.
- The name board may be kept in each plant species in which the common name along with binomial name may be mentioned. The year of planting and economic importance with medicinal values if any may be mentioned in some plants so that the oldest as well as useful herbal plants may be identified in the campus.


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- There is a need to check the water flow in toilets.
- The drinking water facility (RO) need to be monitored so is the quality of water could be checked from other external agencies.
- Drive to segregate waste at source with clear labels stating biodegradable and non-biodegradable.
- Rainwater harvesting could be implemented in T block Scient campus.
- Inhouse composting such as vermicomposting could be planned.
- Bins to be kept in the washrooms and toilets, different bins for Biodegradable and non-biodegradable as wet and dry waste bins can be kept across the campus.
- Classrooms can be made free from melds on ceiling.
- Students can be encouraged to paint the college surroundings with slogans highlighting the nature conservation and environment protection.

11. Conclusion

Scient Institute of Technology is a educational institution or a constituent part of one. A college may be a degree-awarding educational institution is an international community that nurtures students learning, fosters faculty research, creatives activity, and provides services to the larger community.
