

5. Audit Observations

Flora and Fauna in the campus

Ensuring the rich biodiversity in the green campus is an important parameter which reflected the real-time ecosystem. Plants are indicators for assessing the varying levels of environmental quality. In general, plants improve the outdoor air quality with increased oxygen levels and reduced temperature and carbon-di-oxide. The green and varying colour of the flowering plants improve the ambience of the environment. The record on maintenance of the plant biomass and its management are important with respect to green campus initiatives. The existence of such plants and birds in the green campus may be recorded for the rich flora and fauna which are being considered as a value addition to the campus.

The observations indicated that the Scient college campus the commonly available native as well as wild plant species in the college campus are Neem (*Azadirachta indica*), Mango (*Mangifera indica*), Guava (*Psidium guajava*), Coconut (*Cocos nucifera*), Hibiscus (*Hibiscus rosa sinensis*), Royal poinciana (*Delonix regia*), Jackfruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), False Ashoka (*Monoon longifolium*), Fig (*Ficus racemosa*), Sacred Fig (*Ficusreligiosa*), Singapore Cherry (*Muntingia calabura*), Yellow Flame tree (*Peltophorum pterocarpum*), Orchid tree (*Bauhinia variegata*), Weeping fig (*Ficus Benjamina*), Spider plant.

The predominant families of various monocot and dicot plants found in the Scinet campus are Arecaceae, Fabaceae, Anacardiaceae, Myrtaceae, Vitaceae, Moraceae, Muntingiaceae, Proteaceae, Annonaceae, Lauraceae.

The visiting and living birds in the campus are Shikra (Accipiter badius) Crow (Corvus splendens), Pigeon (Columba livia domestica), Birds (Aves), Garden lizard (Calotes versicolor), Butterfly (Euploea core), Squirrel (Sciurus sp.), Carpenter ants (Camponotus sp.). Barn owl (Tyto alba) was seen perching in one of the trees.

More than 25% of campus is covered with greenery.

The campus has a good number of trees, plants, shrubs and lawns. It is further observed that all the plants are growing profusely and showing healthier free from pests and diseases attack.

The main source of water is bore well source and open well

5.3. Solid Waste Management




