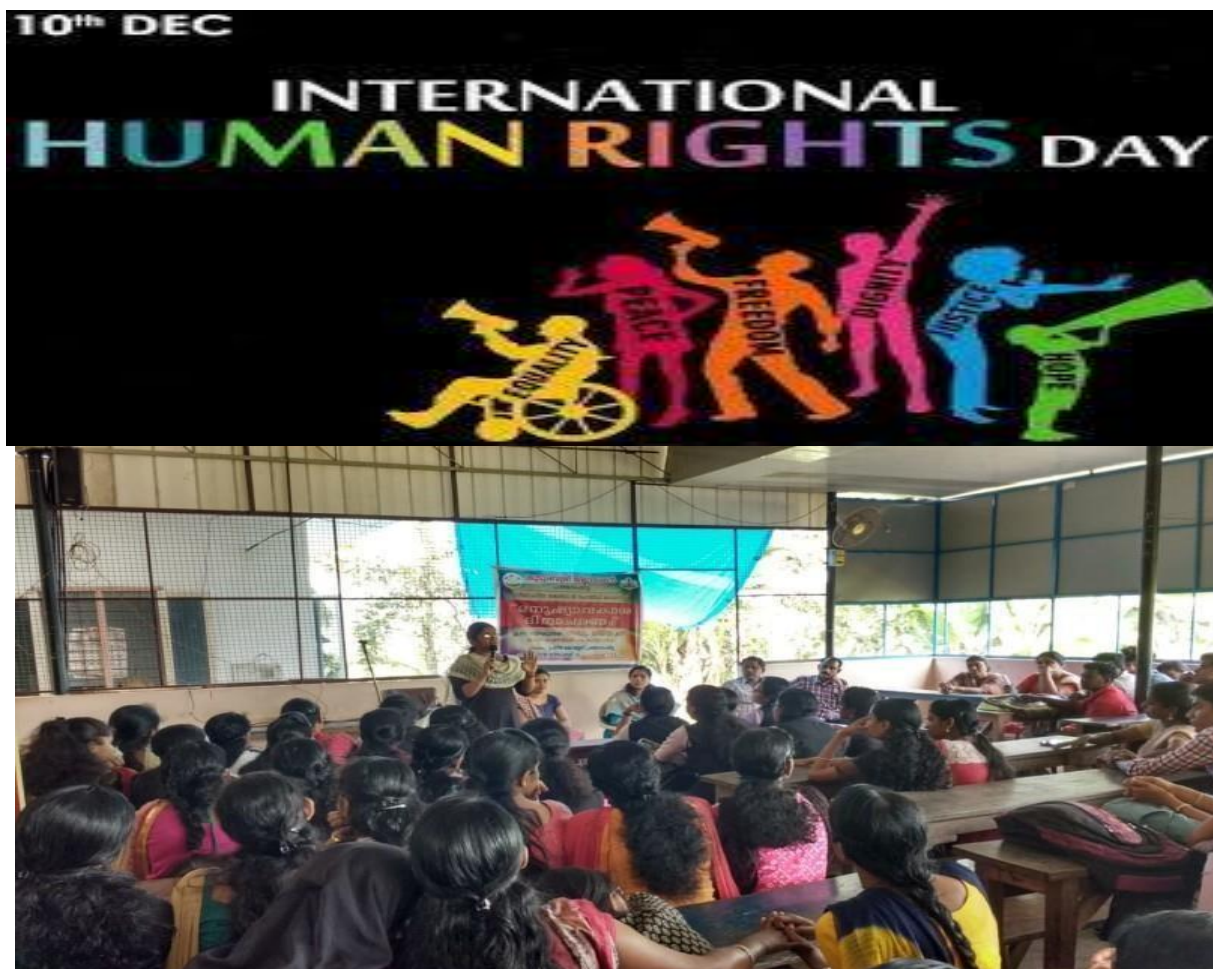

### GANDHI JAYANTI CELEBRATIONS

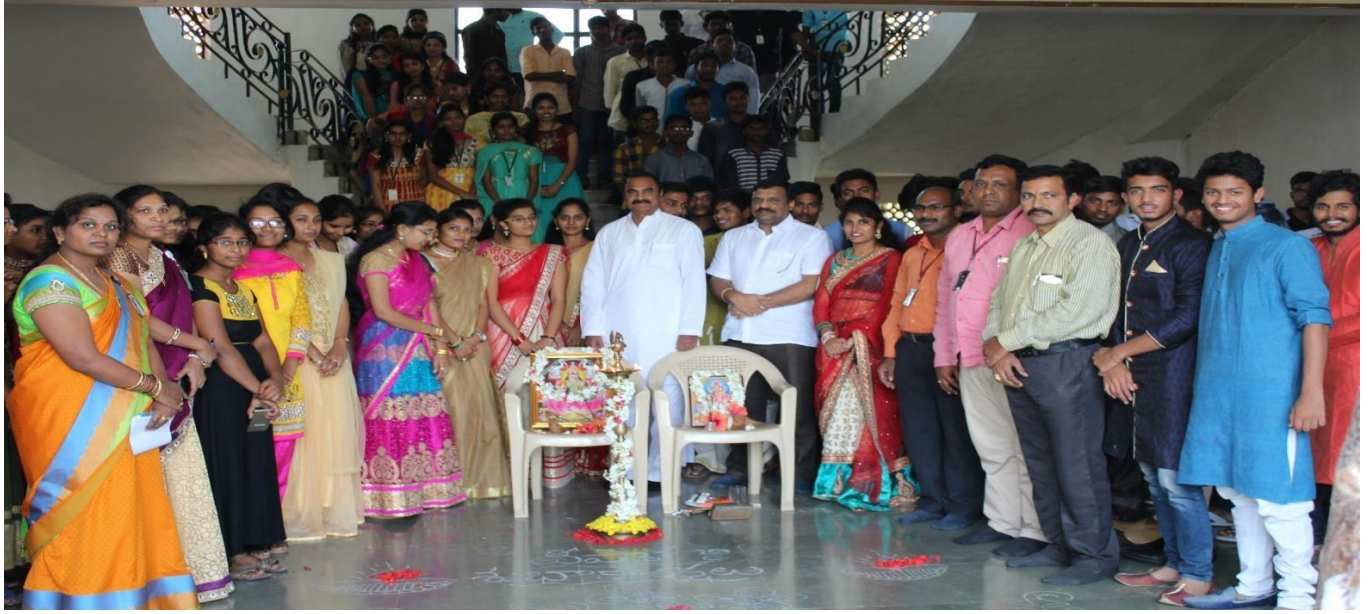
**“I suppose leadership at one time meant muscles, but today it means getting along with people.”-Mahatma Gandhi**

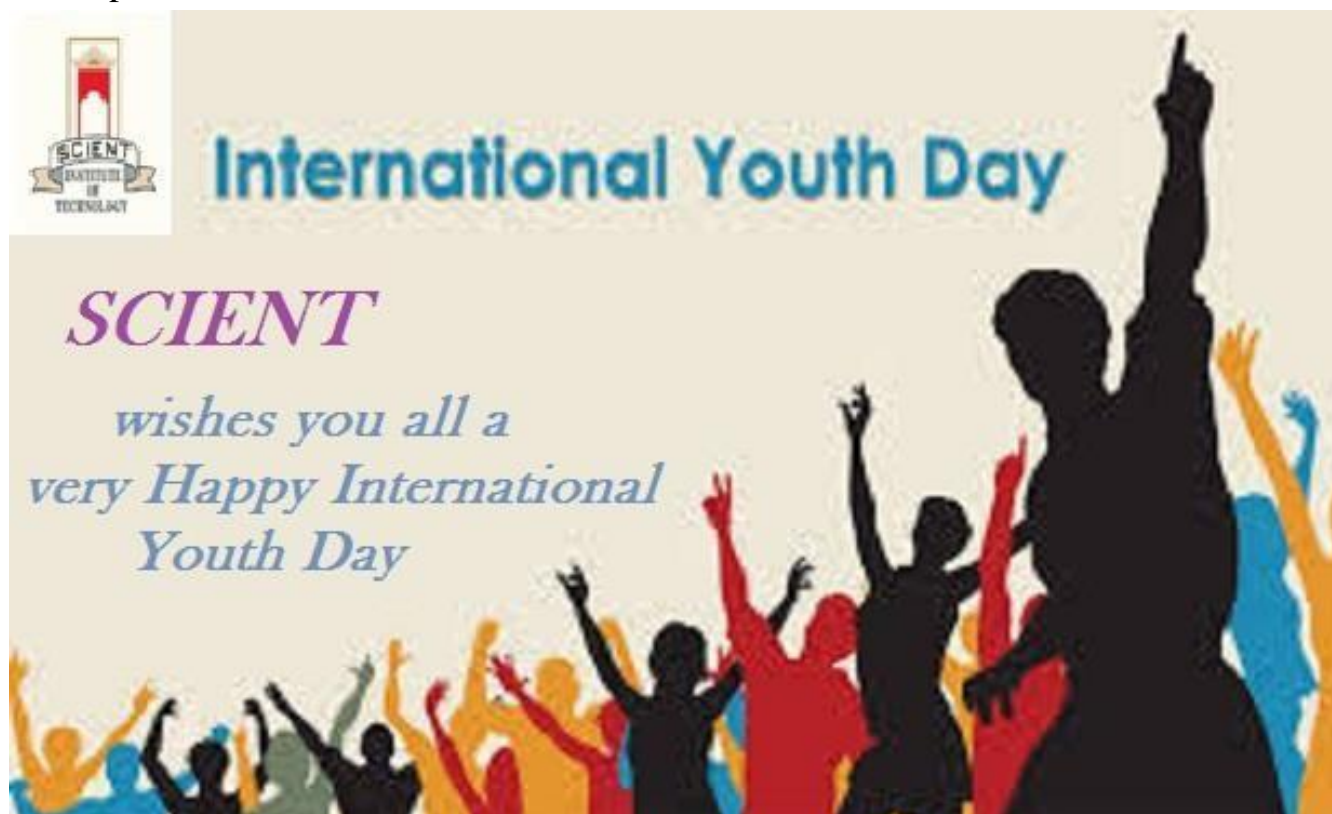
